- How many columns? how labelled?
- Look for possible (diagonal) cause-and-effect chains e.g. social consequences of the Great Plague
- Some "gaps" in the table...e.g.: Britain somewhat deficient in musicians and metaphysicians, but better-endowed with historians and epistemologists.
